Market Potential for RES in CEEC

- Large RES potentials
 - Feasibility for exploitation depends on various factors
 - Availability of domestic technologies and local know-how
 - Need for electric energy and heat
 - Legislative and administrative supporting schemes
 - Additional economic incentives
 - Strong local actors and well-working alliances
 - Access to financial resources
- Successful RES actions must be well defined!

Feasible RES actions

- Biomass co-firing in conventional power plants
- Production of biomass commodities
- Landfill refurbishment for methane gas combustion
- Conversion of boiler houses to biomass feedstock (possibly with co-generation)
